### How many?


## A song

We sang Big Family of God while we remembered people in our church family.

#### How to make paper chain people

1. Cut a piece of paper in half lengthways.





- 2. Take one of the halves and fold it in half widthways. Then fold each side back on itself, so that you have a zigzag.
- 3. Put the folded paper on the table and draw the shape of a person on it. Make sure the hands and feet reach the sides, this is where the people will join together.





- 4. Keeping the paper folded, cut away the paper around the edges of your person.
- 5. Unfold, and you should have a chain of four people joined together.
- 6. Now you can colour them in! If you make more, you can join them into a bigger chain using tape.
