Something to make

Is your bag ready for a new look? You could make a keyring to put on your bag so that when you're out and about you remember to chat about Jesus.

You will need:

- A label made from cardboard or plastic – old cereal boxes or milk bottles can be cut to shape.
- A hole punch or scissors to make a hole in the label.
- Pens to write and decorate the label (permanent marker if using plastic label)
- Thread, string, ribbon or a rubber band to hang the label on
- Beads, old buttons or other decorations (optional)
- An old keyring (optional)



When you have cut your label to the right shape, make a hole in one end. Then write Jesus on your label and colour or decorate it.

Using your thread, string, ribbon or rubber band, loop it through the hole and tie to your bag or to an old keyring. If you want to put beads on the thread, put them on before you tie the loop. Or you could sew together old buttons each side of the label and attach to the loop with thread. Done!

Do you have some toy animals at your house? You could play a pretending game where one of them goes to tell the others about Jesus.
