Paint a picture

You could paint your own picture with a cross and poppies like Kate did in the video. You will need:

- Paper
- A black felt-tip pen
- Red and green paint, brown paint (optional)
- An old sponge and sharp scissors
- A straw (optional)
- A paintbrush, a cup of water to clean it, an apron, newspaper to keep your table clean.

Start by writing at the top of your paper, something like "Jesus died so we can live. John 3:16"

Then paint a green hill at the bottom of your paper. Next paint a brown cross on the hill – if you don't have brown paint you can mix red and green.

Ask your grown-up to use the sharp scissors to cut the sponge into a poppy shape (start with an oval and then cut v-shapes into each side).

Dip your poppy-shaped sponge into red paint and stamp all over the hill and around the cross to make a field of poppies.

Use your straw or paintbrush to paint stalks for the poppies in green paint.

Wait until the picture is completely dry. Then for the finishing touch, draw a spot in the middle of each poppy with your black pen. Done!
